# **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

Appearance must always be neat and in accordance with school rules. Gill Primary learners must take pride in their appearance and behaviour. A learner's hair, nails, body and clothing must, at all times, be clean and well groomed.



## **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

Only approved school uniform may be worn.

#### 1. SUMMER:

<u>Boys</u>: Short grey school pants, white short-sleeved shirt with the school badge, long grey

socks and black school shoes with laces (no boots) or barefoot.

<u>PT wear</u>: Gill PT shorts, maroon Gill sport shirt with white socks and takkies or barefoot. Should a school tracksuit be worn, white socks and takkies are

compulsory. Secret socks are not allowed.

Girls: Black gingham Gill school dress, short white socks and black school shoes or

barefoot. Girls are allowed to wear short black leggings under the school dress,

but it may not be visible.

<u>PT wear</u>: Gill PT shorts/skort, maroon Gill sport shirt with white school socks and takkies **or** barefoot. Should a school tracksuit be worn, white school socks and

takkies are compulsory. Secret socks are not allowed.

#### 2. WINTER:

Boys: Long or short grey school pants, white long or short-sleeved shirt, Gill tie, long

grey school socks, black school shoes with laces (no boots) and black jersey/Gill

tracksuit top.

<u>PT wear</u>: School tracksuit, Gill PT shorts or black PT shorts, maroon Gill long/short-sleeved sport shirt with white socks and takkies. **Secret socks and** 

under vests are not allowed.

Girls: Grey school pants, white long-sleeved shirt, Gill tie, long black school socks, black

school shoes and black jersey/Gill tracksuit top **or** Black gingham Gill school dress, long black school socks, black school shoes and black jersey/Gill tracksuit

top.

<u>PT wear</u>: School tracksuit, Gill PT shorts/scort, maroon Gill long/short-sleeved sport shirt with white school socks and takkies. **Secret socks are not allowed.** 

- 3. Gill sportswear/school tracksuit must be worn **only on the days** that learners have PT, instead of school uniform.
- 4. Winter uniform worn officially from 1 May until 31 August.
- 5. **School uniforms** are available from The Sport Shop and Embroiderzelle.

- 6. **Sport uniforms** may be ordered through the school. No stock is available at school, but a few samples are available to fit on for sizing only. **Orders are placed only when CASH payment has been received.**
- 7. **Second-hand clothing shop:** We encourage parents to please donate all unwanted/unused school uniform items, which will be sold in our second hand shop. Donations can be dropped at the secretary's office.

#### Netball:

#### **Hockey:**

- Black Gill shorts/skort

- maroon Gill sport shirt (long/short)

- long black socks

- takkies

#### Tennis:

- Black Gill shorts/skort

- maroon Gill sport shirt

- white school socks

- white takkies

- black Gill cap

# Swimming:

- Black one-piece swimming costume

- maroon swimming cap (compulsory)

**Rugby:** Teams play with sponsored rugby jerseys supplied by the school. **Cricket:** Black caps and white hats are available for purchase at the school.

Girls:

Black "peaks" are available for purchase at the school.

Swimming:

Maroon swimming caps are available at the school.

**Hockey:** Each girl must supply her own hockey stick, shin pads and socks.

Golf: Each player must supply their own golf clubs.

Target shooting: Each player must supply their own rifle (4.5 Air).

#### **IMPORTANT:**

1. The **length** of the girls' scort must be no shorter than the midway of their thigh.

 During sport practice, girls must be dressed in shorts/scort and a t-shirt. Leggings/tights and strappy tops alone <u>ARE NOT ALLOWED</u>. Girls <u>must</u> dress appropriately.

3. When travelling by bus on "away" matches, learners must, at all times, be neatly dressed in their school tracksuit/sport clothes.

# **SCHOOL BAGS**

- 1. Only **BLACK or NAVY** school bags with solid partitions inside, are allowed.
- 2. No school trolley bags are allowed.
- 3. No writing/drawings, except for the learner's name, may be on the outside of school bags.

# APPEARANCE OF LEARNERS

Appearance must at all times be neat and in accordance with school rules. Gill Primary learners must take pride in their appearance and behaviour. A learner's hair, nails, body and clothing must, at all times, be clean and well groomed. No deviating hairstyles will be allowed for girls or boys – no gel or "punk-styles" will be allowed.

- 1. Boys should have their hair cut according to the school requirements, i.e. may not touch the collar or ears. No shaved patterns, gel or any other unnatural hair products are allowed to style hair.
- 2. Girls with long hair:
  - Hair must be braided or tied back in ponytails (no more than two);
  - No rolls or hives permitted;
  - Hair must be styled against the head;
  - All hair accessories, for example elastic bands, ribbons and alice bands may be **maroon** or **black** only, without decorations.
- 2. Girls with hair extensions:
  - Hair extensions may only be in **thin** braiding;
  - Only natural colour hair extensions allowed;
  - Hair must be braided or tied back in ponytails (no more than two);
  - No rolls or hives permitted;
  - Hair must be styled against the head;
  - All hair accessories, for example elastic bands, ribbons and alice bands may be **maroon** or **black** only, without decorations.
- Fringe length: Short 1cm above the eye brows;
   Long clipped back or held back with an alice band.
- 4. No colour washes, highlights or lowlights permitted only natural colour allowed.
- 5. No make-up and/or nail polish may be worn.
- 6. No jewellery, except for watches, may be worn. Girls may wear small solid gold/silver round studs or small gold/silver earrings (not bigger than 1cm in diameter) in their ears and only one stud or ring per ear may be worn.
- 7. Black scarves and black beanies may be worn during winter. Blankets wrapped around the body, are **strictly prohibited**.
- 8. The ties of boys and girls are to be fully tied at all times.
- 9. If a learner's **birthday** falls on a school day, the learner may wear **civvies** to school on that specific day.
- 10. <u>Civvie days</u>: Girls are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> to wear leggings/tights, strappy tops, torn clothes, high heel shoes, make-up or jewellery to school. Hair styles are to be styled as mentioned above. Girls must dress appropriately.
