## SPORT AND CULTURE

## SPORT AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

1. A learner must participate in the educational programme of the school as prescribed by the Department of Education and Governing Body, except where exemptions have been granted from such activities by the Department.
2. When a learner has voluntarily joined an extra-mural activity, such a learner must fulfil all relative obligations and responsibilities, for the entire season, except when exempted by the principal.
3. Learners may not use facilities or apparatus belonging to the school, including sport apparatus, outside school hours without the permission of the principal.
4. No learner may show disrespect towards the national symbols of South Africa or the school code of conduct.
5. Every Gill learner must participate in at least one extra-mural activity of the school during summer and one extra-mural activity of the school during winter.

### **THE FOLLOWING SPORTS, EXTRA-MURAL AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES ARE OFFERED AT GILL PRIMARY:**

- Athletics, Swimming, Tennis, Netball, Hockey, Cricket, Rugby, Chess, Land service, Target shooting, Public speaking and Choir
- Private music lessons (guitar, piano and recorder) and Life Skills Theatre lessons are available
- Eisteddfod (drama, music, poems and singing; held annually)
- School concert (every second year)
- Educational outings
- "WOW Spelfees" (held annually)
- General knowledge tests (every term with a trophy awarded to the overall winner at Prize-giving)
- Official school photos (individual, class, academic, sport, music and culture)
- Grade 7 educational **weekend excursion** (beginning of the fourth term)
- Grade 7 monitor leadership camps (every term)
- Annual sport tour for senior teams (end of the winter sport programme)
